Children who will be five years old by Dec. 1st may be eligible to begin a kindergarten program in the fall. We encourage you and your child to attend our Kindergarten Round Up on April 11th at 6:00 pm. Registration packets can be picked up in the school office beginning in April or on April 11th at Kindergarten Round-Up. State certified birth certificate, official immunization record and proof of residency, such as a current utility bill or rental agreement, are required to complete enrollment.

Educational Environment Questionnaire:

As we strive to create balanced classroom environments beneficial to all students, we ask those who desire to make a request for the 2024-2025 school year, to please **fully complete** our **Educational Environment Questionnaire** and return by **April 12th**. The Questionnaire has been emailed to K-4th grade parents. It can also be picked up in the Elementary office. Please note that this is not a guarantee of placement.

M-STEP TEST INFORMATION for 3rd, 4th & 5th Grades:

This will be our ninth year of M-STEP testing. English Language Arts and Math will be assessed in 3rd, 4th and 5th grades. 5th grade will also be assessed in Social Studies and Science. This is a multi-day assessment and students **must be present** each day the test is given in order for their score to count. **State assessments are not optional**, and parents do not have the right to opt their child out of an assessment. Without this test information we lose important data that is useful in making instructional decisions for our students. If your child has appointments during a scheduled test date, please make every effort to reschedule on a non-testing day.

The M-Step Test Window is Mid-April to Mid-May. Please watch for more specific dates from your child's teacher. To promote student success:

- -Get a good night's rest. -Eat a nutritious breakfast.
- -Be present on test dates (make-ups tend to show decreased scores and students miss out on in-class learning). For information regarding M-STEP or if you would like to view sample questions, go to: www.michigan.gov/mstep
