#### 98C Presentation:

Mr. Nelson shared an overview of how the district plans to address student-learning loss. Section 98c is a grant that helps districts to develop and implement plans to address learning loss related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Areas to be addressed include assessments, implementing evidence-based activities, assisting parents to support students and tracking student performance and engagement. The district will utilize Fastbridge and Horizon for assessments and tracking. Trails and Character Strong will be tools used to address student social emotional learning.

Lisa Geister, a parent in the district questioned the board about Apex Learning. Her question related to who is eligible for online learning and what she can do to enroll her student.
