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Bus Riders Must Establish a Daily Routine Schedule

Our goal is to get your child home as safely as possible. As we strive to make our bus system more efficient and safer we would like to remind you of our transportation policy. All bus riders will establish a routine schedule. Students will be required to ride home from school on their assigned bus to their regular drop off location. There will be no riding of any buses other than your child's assigned bus. If you are not going to be home, you will have to make other arrangements or have someone meet your children at their assigned bus stop if you are unable to be there. If you decide to pick your child up instead of them riding the bus, please call the elementary office by 1:30 pm. Families absent from the bus for two or more consecutive mornings must notify the bus garage when they are ready to return to school. The bus will not stop unless the bus garage has been contacted. Please review "School Bus Rules/Policies" on page 12 of the student handbook. Call our Transportation Supervisor, Kristy Thompson, at 231-856-4676 if you have any bus questions or concerns.

CHARACTER TRAITS - Each month we will be learning about and discussing character traits. September is **RESPECT**. **Respect**; Seeing good in people and things and treating them with care. To "see good" in people often requires us to learn more about who they are, where they come from, and why they believe and act the way they do. Respect is about understanding people! MS ELEMENTARY PROCEDURE REVIEW

Please take a moment to review our basic building procedures. Complete information is available in the handbook. We appreciate your cooperation!

Circle Drive Traffic in Front of the Elementary

- •CLOSED to traffic from 7:30 AM to 8:30 AM.
- •OPEN from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM for students arriving late or leaving early.
- •CLOSED again between 2:30 PM and 3:30 PM.
- •OPEN to library patrons at all times.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up and Parent Parking

Parents should use the new parking lot in front between the two buildings to drop off and pick up students. This is where you should park if you are picking up your students at the end of the day or if you need to enter the building for an extended amount of time during the school day.

Building Security/Pick Up Procedures

- •For the safety and security of our students, exterior doors will be locked during the day except the front door which will allow you access to the office only.
- •All visitors are required to check in at the office.
- Parents are asked to remain outside at the south side of the building when picking up your children at the end of the day.
- •Children being picked up will be dismissed shortly before the bus riders.
- •Teachers escort students to the south doors, where they can be picked up as they exit the building. Classes will be dismissed in 3 to 5 minute intervals starting with Kindergarten.
- Kindergarten and 1st graders will have older students escort them out until they learn the procedure.

Medication Policy is in the Handbook

Parents must bring medication to the office and sign a release in order for us to administer medication.

Do not send medication in with students.
